Directions

From south of Appleton: From U.S. Highway 41 north, take exit number 137, College Avenue. Proceed right (east) on College Avenue for three miles to downtown Appleton. The Fox Cities Performing Arts Center is on the left between Walnut and Division Streets.

From north of Appleton: From U.S. Highway 41 south, take exit number 142, Richmond Street (Highway 47). Proceed left (south) for three miles to College Avenue. Turn left on College Avenue. The Fox Cities Performing Arts Center is on the left between Walnut and Division Streets.

Courtesy Reminders

We highly recommend reviewing basic theater etiquette before attending the performance. Upon entering the building, please dispose of any candy, food or gum in the garbage cans located near the entrances.

Arrival and Parking

Doors to the theater open 30 minutes prior to the performance. Please arrive in a timely manner, no later than 10 minutes before the performance, to ensure ample time to get seated. Upon arrival at the theater, buses should use the parking map and follow the directions of the staff outside to assist them in finding a parking location. Cars and other vehicles may find parking in the Washington Street ramp for a nominal fee or find available parking in metered spaces along the street. After parking, unload your students and make your way into the Fox Cities Performing Arts Center.

Checking In and Seating

Please enter the Fox Cities Performing Arts Center at the corner of College Avenue or at the doors on Division Street and have one member of your group check in at the table in the main lobby. You will be given your seat locations and adult nametags at that time and volunteers will guide you to your seats. Please fill every seat since your group has only been assigned enough seats for your reservation. No printed tickets are issued for Thrivent Financial for Lutherans Education Series performances.

Bus Drivers

Bus drivers are welcome to relax in the Dress Circle lobby and enjoy a cup of coffee during the performance. If space permits, drivers may request to attend the performance at the check in table in the main lobby.

Theater Amenities

Elevators are located on the east side of the lobby and serve all seating levels. Restrooms are located on the Orchestra, Dress Circle and Grand Tier levels. All restrooms are wheelchair-accessible and there is a family restroom located on the Orchestra Level. Please remember to notify the Center in advance of any special seating needs or requests.

Departure

After the performance, Fox Cities Performing Arts Center personnel will dismiss all groups from the theater. Please remain in the theater until dismissed and check around your seats for personal items before leaving. Once dismissed, return to your bus or vehicle for a safe trip back to school.

ARRIVAL AND PARKING Buses and vehicles should find a parking location before unloading students. The primary bus parking location is the parking lot located behind the Fox Cities Performing Arts Center. Secondary parking locations are along Washington Street as marked on the map. Other vehicles may park in the parking ramp for a dollar, or find available parking in metered spaces along the street. After parking, unload your students and make your way into the Fox Cities Performing Arts Center. Handicap buses may use the valet parking pull in on Division Street to drop off students, but may not park there.
